It is the intent of the membership of the Club to support and promote breeding programs which would continue to improve the quality of the breed. To this end, careful attention must be paid to the soundness, natural ability, tractability and conformation of the sire and dam of each litter. In order to establish minimum criteria for demonstrating these characteristics, the following method of evaluating suitability of stud dogs and brood bitches for breeding programs is suggested. Stud dogs and brood bitches must: • be AKC registered or registered with a foreign registry. • be clear of any hereditary disorders such as epilepsy. • be sound in temperament as well as conformation. • have proven their ability to contribute to the breed through having earned conformation points, or working titles and/or have at least four dogs in their pedigree within three generations that have earned such distinctions.
